#### Group Project: Provision: Generosity Engine

- Provision is a proposed personal finance web app that uses a proprietary feature, called the Generosity Engine, to help people engage in more acts of generosity in their community
- Our client had no concepts for how Generosity Engine would work or what it would look like
- We designed the Generosity Engine to gain knowledge from the user's habits, provide personalized recommendations for donating money and time, and allowing the user to budget their time and donations the same way they would their personal finances
- I primarily designed the guided onboarding, modular and customizable widgets, budgeting data visualizations, and volunteering/donation flows
- Deliverables included research synthesis, style guide, interactive prototype, annotated wireframes, architecture diagram

#### Solo Project: Lefty Mode

- Lefty Mode is an accessibility tool I designed to improve reachability for lefties on their mobile devices
- Nearly 80% of important UI elements on mobile websites are placed in areas of the screen that are considered unreachable for lefties
- Lefty Mode physically moves those UI elements to the left side of the screen to make them more reachable
- Lefty mode is quick to enable, easily reversible, and customizable for the user
- I am currently working with a developer to bring Lefty Mode to market as a mobile app

#### Group Project: Northstar Behavioral Health

- NBH wants to engage with a larger audience and maintain engagement across multiple touchpoint
- Engaged in stakeholder interviews and performed secondary research to learn more about the problem space
- Designed suite of physical media touchpoints as well as a mobile app to bring users to NBH and keep them engaged throughout the entire spectrum of treatment and into recovery

#### Solo Project: Finotta

- Finotta is a mobile app designed to let users build their wealth, and features a "health score" that goes up as the user completes tasks
- Engaged in stakeholder interviews and performed Kano analysis to learn Finotta's goals and determine user needs
- Designed and proposed four new features to refine onboarding, introduce more gamification, enhance dashboard functionality, and provide feedback to the user for their actions
- Delivered features using annotated wireframes to Finotta CEO
